Under Agenda Item 11d, “District 9 Update”, Council Member Cognevich asked if there were any updates on the contracts and when the project would be started Mrs. Carter stated that they are working on moving the files to Bldg. 100 in the President’s wing. In regard to Ft. Jackson, Mr. Edgecombe brought the mower back but, the ruts in the Fort need to be fixed by the Orange Festival.

Under Agenda Item 11e, “District 5 Update” Council Member McCarty provided an update on the Bridge and also stated that the last day that the Bridge office in Belle Chasse would be open is was January 9, 2026.

Under Agenda Item 11f, the Finance Report from the finance department was provided.

Under Agenda Item 11g, “District 6 Update”, Council Member Newsom spoke in regard to the DNR Loan and the Hurricane Bond. He stated that the DNR Bond is \$16M and the Hurricane Bond is \$12M.

There being no further business to come before this Council, on Motion of Council Member McCarty, seconded by Council Member Newsom, and on roll call all members present voting “YES”, except Council Member Edwards who was “ABSENT”, the meeting adjourned at 3:58 p.m.
