7           Open Meetings Law as it relates to public comment period. The law states that public comment  
8           must take place before the governing body takes any action. Action is defined as board discussion  
9           or resulting motions on the item so once the item is offered and receives a second the public  
10          comment period for that agenda item begins. This is not a question and answer period but a time  
11          to hear public comment on the subject before Council discussion commences. The intent of the  
12          law is that public comments should inform and direct the Council’s decision. Included in the body  
13          of this resolution are guidelines for informing the public of the agenda items and their intent by  
14          posting on the Parish website. *The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by*  
15          *the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.*

16          WHEREAS, Louisiana Open Meetings Law dictates that a public comment period is allowed at  
17          any point in the meeting prior to action on an agenda item upon which a vote is to be taken; and

18          WHEREAS, it is incumbent for the Council to comply with this Law in order for said body to hear  
19          public comment prior to any discussion on the agenda item; and

20          WHEREAS, the intent of the law is for public comment to inform and direct the Council’s  
21          decisions; and

22          WHEREAS, efforts to establish protocol to ensure the public has access to information that can  
23          formulate informed public comment must be in place; and

24          WHEREAS, both the draft and final agendas will include not only the preamble, but also a digest  
25          for each ordinance and resolution;

26          NOW, THEREFORE:

27          BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION 1

24          Justine A. DeMolle as Director of the Plaquemines Parish Tourist Commission to serve a three  
25          year term replacing Mitch Jurisich.

27          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT it hereby  
28          appoints Rosemary J. White and Richie Blink, as new Directors of the Plaquemines Parish Tourist  
29          Commission to serve a three year term.

31          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT in  
32          accordance with the provisions of LSA-R.S. 33:4574(f)(b)(ii), the term of office for the board  
33          member named above shall run from the date of adoption of this Resolution to December 31, 2025,  
34          or until each member's successor in office is duly appointed and commissioned in accordance with  
35          law.



The Empire South Pass Tarpon Rodeo would like to nominate Rosemary J. White to serve on the Plaquemines Parish Tourism Commission (PPTC).





2       A Resolution authorizing the execution with a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement  
3       by and between Plaquemines Parish Government and the Plaquemines Parish  
4       Tourism Commission related to the maintenance, repair and operation of Fort  
5       Jackson; and to provide for related matters.  
6

7       WHEREAS, Fort Jackson is a historic masonry fort located 40 miles (64 km) up river from  
8       the mouth of the Mississippi River in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana; and  
9

10       WHEREAS, Fort Jackson is a National Historic Landmark. It was damaged by  
11       Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, and its condition is threatened; and  
12

13       WHEREAS, Fort Jackson is owned by Plaquemines Parish Government; and  
14

15       WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Tourism Commission has as its mission to foster tourism in  
16       Plaquemines Parish; and  
17

18       WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Tourism Commission receives revenue from the  
19       hotel/motel tax already being collected in Plaquemines Parish on the rental of sleeping rooms,  
20       cottages or cabins; and  
21

22       WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Tourism Commission has revenues to facilitate the  
23       maintenance, repair and operation of Fort Jackson; and  
24

25       WHEREAS, the maintenance, repair and operation of Fort Jackson will benefit tourism and  
26       overall economic activity in Plaquemines Parish;  
27

28       NOW, THEREFORE:

29  
30       BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT the Parish President  
31       is directed to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement by and between Plaquemines Parish  
32       Government and Plaquemines Parish Tourism Commission to allow for the Plaquemines Parish  
33       Tourism Commission to maintain, repair and operate Fort Jackson.  
34

35       BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL that the  
36       Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release  
37       this Resolution and that Parish employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes  
38       of this Resolution, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.
