The following Resolution was offered by Commissioner Champagne who moved its adoption:

5       competitive bids to provide upgrades to the Alliance Water Booster Station and  
6       Feed Lines; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

8       DIGEST: DOTD is contributing funds to the Alliance Booster Station project. To adhere to the  
9       guidelines, as set forth by DOTD, the Resolution is necessary for Kyle Associates, LLC to proceed  
10      with advertising for competitive bids for upgrades to the Alliance Water Booster Station and Feed  
11      Lines, a port improvement project under the Port Construction and Development Priority Program.  
12      *The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual*  
13      *ordinance or resolution.*

14  
15      WHEREAS, Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District has submitted an application for  
16      funding of the Alliance Water Booster Station and Feed Lines Upgrades port improvement project  
17      under the Port Construction and Development Priority Program; and

18  
19      WHEREAS, Alliance Water Booster Station and Feed Lines Upgrades has been recommended to  
20      the Louisiana Joint Legislative Committee of Transportation, Highways, and Public Works by the  
21      Department of Transportation and Development for funding by the Port Construction and  
22      Development Priority Program; and

23  
24      WHEREAS, no funds have been made available by the State for construction of the project and  
25      the Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District has available local funds in an amount of not  
26      less than one hundred (100%) percent to insure construction of the project; and

27  
28      WHEREAS, Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District desires to utilize its own funds for  
29      the construction of this Project and to be reimbursed by the Port Construction and Development  
30      Priority Program once funding becomes available, in accordance with R.S. 34:3457; and

31  
32      WHEREAS, at the request of this Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District, Kyle  
33      Associates, L.L.C. has prepared plans and specifications for said project, which plans and  
34      specifications are designated by State Project No. H.014966 (321); and

35  
36      WHEREAS, this Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District has reviewed the final plans,  
37      specifications and cost estimate and has submitted them to the Department of Transportation and  
38      Development. The Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District will accept the final plans and  
39      specifications contingent on the Department of Transportation and Development's final approval  
40      inasmuch as they comply with the requirements of the Port Construction and Development Priority  
41      Program; and

43      WHEREAS, all necessary servitudes, rights-of-way, spoil disposal areas, rights of ingress and  
44      egress and the means thereof have been acquired by this Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal  
45      District, and the titles thereto are valid and indefeasible; and

46  
47      WHEREAS, this Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District has obtained all necessary  
48      permits required for the construction of this project; and

49  
50      WHEREAS, Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District has agreed to accomplish all  
51      necessary utilities, fence and other facilities relocations and alterations made necessary by this  
52      project; and

53  
54      WHEREAS, the Official Journal for the Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District is The  
55      Plaquemines Gazette, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 700 Belle Chasse, LA 70037, and whose  
56      telephone number is (504) 392-1619; and

60 WHEREAS, this Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District desires to advertise for  
61 competitive bids, in accordance with LRS 38:2212, et seq., for the award of a contract in the name  
62 of the (Public Entity), and furnish engineering services during the progress of the work;

76 GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR & TERMINAL  
77 DISTRICT THAT the Department of Transportation and Development be and hereby is assured  
78 that all necessary servitudes, rights-of-way, rights of ingress and egress and the means thereof have  
79 been obtained by Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District, and the titles thereto are valid  
80 and infeasible and Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District expressly agrees to defend  
81 any action for the failure of any servitude, right-of-way, right of ingress or egress, and Plaquemines  
82 Port Harbor and Terminal District does hereby assume complete responsibility for providing  
83 engineering services during construction and the maintenance and upkeep of the project after  
84 construction.

105 GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT, HARBOR & TERMINAL  
106 DISTRICT THAT the Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District does hereby save and hold  
107 harmless the Department of Transportation and Development against any loss or damage of any  
108 kind incident to or occasioned by Activities undertaken in pursuance of this agreement and

10   WHEREAS, through negotiations with Odeh, a recommendation is being made to approve the  
11   acquisition of property owned by Odeh, and known as one of the “piano keys”; and

13   WHEREAS, the negotiations between Odeh and the Port recognize a total recommended  
14   purchase price of said property for \$270,000 for Lot 59, Pointe Celeste Farms S/D, currently  
15   owned by Odeh; and

17   NOW, THEREFORE:

19   BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE GOVERNING

24   It hereby authorizes and directs Charles Tillotson, Executive Director of the Plaquemines Port,  
25   Harbor and Terminal District, to acquire the land owned by Husam Odeh, more fully described  
26   by the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

30   The acquisition shall be for a purchase price of \$ 270,000 plus closing cost for the transfer of  
31   ownership of the land at Lot 59 Pointe Celeste Farms S/D, currently owned by Husam Odeh, to  
32   the Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District.

36   The Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and  
37   release this Ordinance and that Port employees and officials are authorized to carry out the  
38   purposes of this Ordinance, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish

A CERTAIN LOT OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all of the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana, in that part thereof known as **POINT CELESTE FARMS SUBDIVISION, PHASE 2**, designated as **LOT 59** on a plan of subdivision by Tildon J. Dufrene (Dufrene Surveying & Engineering, Inc.), dated September 8, 2000, approved by Plaquemines Parish Council Ordinance No. 00-258, registered in COB 989 folio 758, Conveyance Records of Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana. And according to said plan, said LOT 59 is located and measures as follows:

13   WHEREAS, in order to have ample time to properly prepare for Port meetings, it is the desire of  
14   this Council to establish deadlines for any altered version of legislation already on the agenda; and

7           recognize their contributions to our great parish by renaming the street in their honor. *The digest*

11          WHEREAS, Plaquemines Parish shares a long history with the Croatian people; and

13          WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Council recognizes the importance of the Croatian culture in  
14          Plaquemines Parish and wants to celebrate the Croatian residents and their heritage; and

16          WHEREAS, the Croatian-American Society is in the process of building the Croatian Cultural  
17          Center on Avenue G in Belle Chasse, Louisiana and the Grand Opening is set in early October,

21          “Avenue G” to “Croatian Way”;

The following Ordinance was offered by Council Member Jurisich who moved its adoption:

1           An ordinance to amend, and as amended readopt Ordinance No. 23-17, adopted by  
2           the Parish Council on January 26, 2023, relative to the prohibition of any  
3           Plaquemines Parish-issued permit for authorization, construction and/or operation  
4           of any Mississippi River Sediment Diversion project; and otherwise to provide with  
5           respect thereto.  
6

7           DIGEST: In January or 2023, Ord No. 23-17 was adopted wherein the Council re-affirmed  
8           legislation adopted by the previous council to prohibit any Plaquemines Parish-issued permit for  
9           authorization, construction and/or operation of any Mississippi River Sediment Diversion project.  
10          This Ordinance will now allow the issuance of permits to any Mississippi River Sediment  
11          Diversion which does not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ cps.

13          WHEREAS, Plaquemines Parish Government has consistently opposed large-scale Mississippi  
14          River Sediment Diversion projects, including in its official Coastal Zone Management Plan and  
15          affirmed by its passage of Ordinance No. 14-52; and

23          SECTION 1 of Ordinance No. 23-17 shall now read as follows:

25                 “The Governing Authority of Plaquemines Parish reaffirms its opposition to large-scale  
26                 Mississippi River Sediment Diversion projects, including the MBSD, and any further  
27                 proposed diversion projects and hereby affirms that Mississippi River Sediment Diversion  
28                 projects, including the MBSD, are not compatible with the best interests of Plaquemines  
29                 Parish, its citizens, its economy, and/or its natural resources, and shall not be considered to  
30                 meet any requirements for its official policies and ordinances, including its official Coastal  
31                 Zone Management Plan and its Floodplain Management policies. No required permits for  
32                 planning, research, construction or operation of any Mississippi River Sediment diversion  
33                 project larger than \_\_\_\_\_cfs shall be issued by Plaquemines Parish  
34                 Government.”

36          SECTION 2 of Ordinance No. 23-17 shall now read as follows:

38                 “The Plaquemines Parish President is hereby authorized, directed to and shall immediately  
39                 notify, in writing, all federal agencies involved in the permitting and environmental  
40                 evaluation of the MBSD, the Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority, and  
41                 all agencies, including the LA TIG, involved in funding mechanisms for MBSD and the  
42                 proposed river diversion for Mid-Breton, that Plaquemines Parish, in accordance with its  
43                 policies and ordinances, will not issue any required permit for planning, construction or  
44                 operation of any Mississippi River Sediment diversion project larger than
