SECTION 2

The term of the said agreement shall not exceed \$76,950. The Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District 2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Budget is hereby amended by appropriating \$76,950 to enter into an agreement with Loren C. Scott Associates, Inc. to conduct an updated Economic Impact Analysis Project from the Unreserved/Undesignated Fund Balance.

12 WHEREAS, Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District will select a firm to aid Port
13 personnel by providing critical data necessary to security, planning of future land use
14 development, redevelopment, infrastructure, identifying all port property and structures; and

16 WHEREAS, the selected firm will provide an organizational system for the maintenance of Port
17 land, warehouses, offices, and river structures efficiently and cost-effectively; and
18

19 WHEREAS, Plaquemines Port Harbor and Terminal District will be enabled access to specific
20 Port geospatial data in a user-friendly method on a 24/7 basis. Thereby improving the Port's
21 response to security issues and tenant concerns. The firm will aid the Port and project team in
22 determining which geospatial datasets and attributes will benefit the Port management and
23 security teams; and

25 WHEREAS, the selected GIS consultant will provide domain awareness to Port security and
26 management personnel through the use of real-time data feeds and operational dashboards;

The Mosquito Control Department shall report directly to the Director of Public Service. The Shipyards, Telecommunications, and the Coastal Resource and Protection Departments shall report directly to the Director of Operations. *The digest is for informational purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.*

WHEREAS, Section 5.01 (F.) of the Charter for Local Self-Government for Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana states: Upon recommendation of the parish president, or upon its own motion, the parish council may provide by ordinance for distribution among the departments of any duties and functions not provided for above and may transfer duties and functions herein assigned from one department to another or may consolidate such departments, all as in the judgment of the parish president and the parish council will make for a more orderly and successful operation of parish government; and

WHEREAS, the Parish President of Plaquemines Parish Government recommends the following distribution among the Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government; and

WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Parish Council accepts the recommendation of the Parish President and desires to provide by Ordinance said distribution among the Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION 1

The Parish President shall exercise direct management and control over the following Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Director of Administration, Director of Public Service, Director of Operations, Director of Arts, Parks, and Recreation, Director of Economic Development/Tourism, Public Awareness, Legal Services, and Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness.

The Director of Administration shall have general management and control over the following Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Administration, Finance and Accounting, Sales Tax, Purchasing, Human Resources, Parish Courier, Community Action Agency, Libraries, Grants, and Courthouse Security.

The Director of Public Service shall have general management and control over the following Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Public Service, Buildings, Permits, Planning and Zoning, Engineering and Public Works, Health, Animal Control, Mosquito Control, Fire Fighting and Ambulances, Waterworks & Sewerage, and Maintenance.

The Director of Operations shall have general management and control over the following Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Operations, Flood Control, Road Maintenance-Bridges, Public Right of Way and Maintenance, Solid Waste District 1, Solid Waste District 2, Shipyards and Boat Harbors, Coastal Resource and Protection Department, Telecommunications, Information Technology, GIS Management and Safety.

The Director of Arts, Parks, and Recreation Department shall have general management and control over the following Departments, Offices, and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Recreation, Swimming Pools, Athletic Fields and Tennis Courts.

The Director of Homeland Security shall have general management and control over the following Departments, Offices and Agencies of Plaquemines Parish Government: Homeland Security and 911 Services.

SECTION 2



RESOLUTION NO. 24-

The following Resolution was offered by Council Member McCarty who moved its adoption:

1 A Resolution to establish the policy of the Plaquemines Parish Government with
2 regard to signage about laws restricting the operation of UTV's, ATV's, and golf
3 carts; and to provide with respect thereto.
4

5 *DIGEST:* To direct the Administration to post signs informing of applicable laws
6 restricting operating UTV's and ATV's on public streets. *The digest is for informational*
7 *purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.*
8

9 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 32:299 and 299.3 restrict the operation of off-road
10 vehicles, such as utility terrain vehicles (UTV's) and three-wheelers and four-wheelers (ATV's)
11 that do not meet the requirements for road use;
12

13 WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 32:299.4 restricts the operation of golf carts on public
14 roads;
15

16 WHEREAS, in violation of LRS 32:299, 299.3 and 299.4 people have been operating off-road
17 vehicles and golf carts on public streets in Plaquemines Parish;
18

19 WHEREAS, in order to better inform the public of the prohibitions in Louisiana law, there is a
20 need to post signage on public roads under the jurisdiction of Plaquemines Parish Government;
21

22 WHEREAS, the policy of Plaquemines Parish Government should be to notify the public
23 through the erection of signage on public roads under the jurisdiction of Plaquemines Parish
24 Government;
25

26 WHEREAS, members of the Parish Council are in the best position to determine which public
27 roads in their respective districts would benefit from the erection of signage informing the public
28 of applicable Louisiana laws regarding the operation of UTV's, ATV's, and golf carts;
29

30 WHEREAS, The Charter for Local Self-Government for Plaquemines Parish, Section 3.10(A)
31 provides that the Parish President shall carry out polices adopted by the Council;
32

33 NOW, THEREFORE:

34
35 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL THAT the Plaquemines
36 Parish Council establishes, as the policy of Plaquemines Parish Government, that the Parish
37 President, or his designee, shall cause to have erected signage, as identified below, with 45 days
38 of receipt of a request of a member of the Plaquemines Parish Council, as to a public road within
39 the Council member's district:
40

41 "Louisiana law restricts the operation of UTV's, ATV's, and golf carts on public
