18 week, the specific schedule to be determined by the Council member initiating their
19 employment, or the successor thereof, and shall be unclassified employees who are
20 entitled to the benefits afforded a full-time employee of the Parish. Part-time
21 Administrative assistants shall work less than 28 hours per week, the specific schedule
22 to be determined by the Council member, and shall not be eligible for benefits.

23 (ii) All Administrative Assistants shall maintain a daily time sheet, recording hours worked.
24 Any full-time assistant shall take paid leave or, in the absence of available leave, take
25 unpaid leave, in a week in which the assistant works less than 40 hours.

26 (iii) Administrative Assistants shall work from the Council member's office during ordinary
27 business hours of the Parish, unless directed otherwise by the Council member, but not
28 less than 32 of the 40 hours shall be worked in an official Plaquemines Parish
29 Government building. If the Parish is under a federal, state, or parish declared state of
30 emergency that limits access to government buildings, exceptions will be allowed as
31 directed by the Council member.

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



This Section is intended to be a declaration of official intent within the meaning of Reg. 1.150-2, and certain terms used in this Section shall have the meaning given in such Regulation. All of the expenditures covered by this Section were or will be made on and after the date which is 60 days prior to the effective date of this Resolution or as otherwise allowed by Reg. 1.150-2 which includes, among other things, an exception for "preliminary expenditures" as defined therein.

2. The Port finds and determines that a real necessity exists for the employment of special counsel in connection with the issuance of any bonds for the Projects, and accordingly, Foley & Judell, L.L.P., of New Orleans, Louisiana, as Bond Counsel, is hereby employed to do and perform work of a traditional legal nature as bond counsel with respect to the issuance and sale of said bonds. 47 The Secretary of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify and release
48 this Ordinance and that Port employees and officials are authorized to carry out the purposes of
49 this Ordinance, both without further reading and approval by the Plaquemines Parish Council.
