15 WHEREAS, such section provides that the Parish Council may periodically review the
16 compensation paid to the Parish President and may change same by Ordinance; provided, however,
17 that no Ordinance changing any compensation shall be passed during the last year of a term and
18 further provided that a change shall not become effective during the current term of the Parish
19 President; and

21 WHEREAS, the compensation for the Parish President has not changed since 2011 and it is the
22 opinion of this Council that the compensation for the Parish President should be increased;
23

24 NOW, THEREFORE:

15 WHEREAS, M/V Belle Chasse II is due for its United States Coast Guard 5-year annual drydock
16 needed to keep it operational and in compliance;
