

8   federally required Four-Factor Analysis, the LAP identifies Vietnamese and Spanish speakers as  
9   the primary Limited English Proficiency (LEP) populations interacting with the Port—particularly  
10   in maritime zones tied to the fishing and shrimping industries. *The digest is for informational*  
11   *purposes only and is superseded by the language of the actual ordinance or resolution.*

12   WHEREAS, the Plaquemines Port, Harbor & Terminal District (“the Port”), doing business as the  
13   Louisiana Gateway Port (“LGP”), is a recipient of federal financial assistance and is therefore  
14   required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits discrimination  
15   on the basis of national origin; and

16  
17   WHEREAS, the Port has completed a federally required Four-Factor Analysis to determine the  
18   language needs of the communities it serves, identifying Vietnamese and Spanish as the primary  
19   LEP populations due to their significant concentration in maritime zones, high frequency of Port  
20   interaction, and direct connection to the fishing, shrimping, and maritime labor industries; and

22   WHEREAS, the attached Language Assistance Plan (LAP) establishes procedures for translation  
23   of vital documents, provision of oral interpretation, staff training, public notification, and annual  
24   monitoring, and further ensures compliance with 49 CFR § 21.9(d) and FTA Title VI guidance;

27          BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE SOLE  
28          GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PLAQUEMINES PORT HARBOR & TERMINAL  
29          DISTRICT THAT it hereby authorizes the acceptance and recommendation of Plaquemines Port,  
30          Harbor & Terminal District to enter into a contract with  
31          Tri- State Oil Company, Inc. to supply and deliver on-road and off-road diesel fuel.

33          BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE PLAQUEMINES PARISH COUNCIL AS THE SOLE
